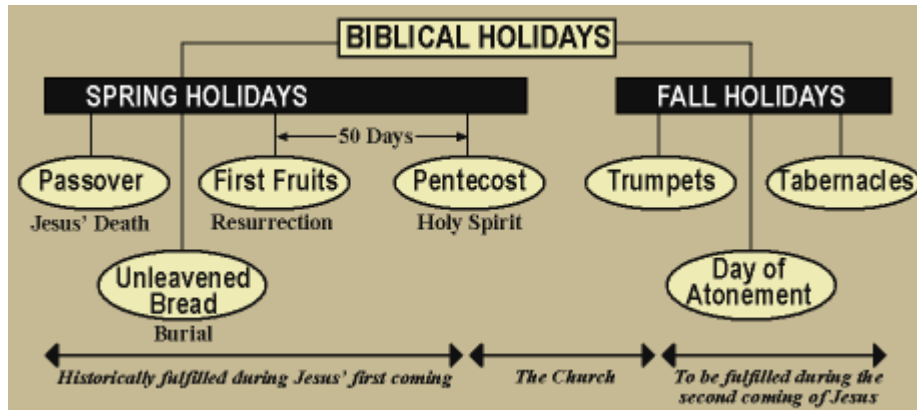


Sitting at the Feet of Rabbi Jesus

The Passover (Lev. 23:4-8)

The Feast of First Fruits (Lev. 23:9-14)

The Feast of Weeks--Pentecost (Lev. 23:15-22)

The Feast of Trumpets (Lev. 23:23-25)

The Day of Atonement (Lev. 23:26-32)

The Feast of Booths (Lev. 23:33-43)
