Scripture Readings

Psalm 27:1-6, 1 John 1:5-10, John 8:12-20

Open with Prayer

Warm-up

- Share about a time you tried finding something in the dark. What was that experience like?
- If you heard the sermon on “I Am the Light of the World”, is there anything that stood out to you?

Talk About It

1. Ask someone to read John 8:12-20. What comes to your mind when you hear Jesus is “the light of the world”?
2. Darkness hides things, but light reveals the truth about something. What is something you found to be true when it was brought to the light—like a rumor, an assumption, a family secret, or a surprise party?
3. God always wants to reveal Him to us, and we see Him most clearly through Jesus (John 1:14). What is one thing you learn about God by observing what Jesus did and said?
4. Read 1 John 1:5-10. Why do you think confession of sins is linked to “walking in the light” here?
5. Jesus came to earth to give light to everyone (John 1:9). Who can you think of that could use Jesus’ light in their life? What can you do to join Jesus in what He is doing in their life?

Read and discuss Psalm 27:1-6.
