God's New Creation

2 Corinthians 5:16-6:2, John 5:19-29

Keeping your house clean is a lot of work—especially with kids in the house. It seems like the list of daily chores grows and grows just to keep up with everything. In fact, some things move from daily to twice daily or else you're drowning in work.

In our house, there are multiple levels of clean. Clean for us is a little different than clean for a visiting family member which is different still from guests for dinner or seeing the house for the first time. In addition to the regular things, you add lots of other tasks to make the place look perfect.

Jesus came to earth to pay the price for our sins and give us everlasting life. When we die, we get to move in with Him and live together forever! Jesus talked about this with His disciples in John 14:

"Let not your hearts be troubled. Believe in God; believe also in me. In my Father's house are many rooms. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you? And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, that where I am you may be also. John 14:1-3

Jesus is preparing a room for you in His Father's mansion right now. Not only that, He has a room for everyone who believes in Him. When we eventually die, we will move in to the new digs and boy will it be amazing. Because here's the thing: The world we live in is plagued with terrible stuff because of sin.
