## 1. If Christ is not risen, our faith is in \_\_\_\_\_.

If Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is vain, your faith also is vain ... If Christ has not been raised, your faith is worthless; you are still in your sins.

**1 Corinthians 15:14,17**

## 2. If Christ is not risen, we have no \_\_\_\_\_.

Then those also who have fallen asleep in Christ have perished. If we have hoped in Christ in this life only, we are of all men most to be pitied. **1 Corinthians 15:18-19**

## 3. If Christ is not risen, our life has no \_\_\_\_\_.

Why are we also in danger every hour? I affirm, brethren, by the boasting in you which I have in Christ Jesus our Lord, I die daily. If from human motives I fought with wild beasts at Ephesus, what does it profit me? **1 Corinthians 15:30-31**

If the dead are not raised, "Let us eat and drink, for tomorrow we die."

## 4. If Christ is risen, \_\_\_\_\_ doesn't matter.

Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moth and rust do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also. **Matthew 6:19-21**

If anyone gives even a cup of cold water to one of these little ones because he is My disciple, I tell you the truth, he will certainly not lose his reward. **Matthew 10:42**

Listen, my dear brothers: Has not God chosen those who are poor in the eyes of the world to be rich in faith and to inherit the kingdom he promised those who love Him? **James 2:5**

## 5. If Christ is risen, our trials do not compare to \_\_\_\_\_.

We are afflicted in every way, but not crushed; perplexed, but not despairing; persecuted, but not forsaken; struck down, but not destroyed: **2 Corinthians 4:8-9**

Because we know that the one who raised the Lord Jesus from the dead will also raise us with Jesus and present us with you in His presence. **2 Corinthians 4:14**

Therefore we do not lose heart. Though outwardly we are wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day. For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all. So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen. For what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal. **2 Corinthians 4:16-18**

## 6. If Christ is risen, to die in Christ is \_\_\_\_\_.

I eagerly expect and hope that I will in no way be ashamed, but will have sufficient courage so that now as always Christ will be exalted in my body, whether by life or by death. For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain. **Philippians 1:20-21**
