“Ask what I shall do for you before I am taken from you.” And Elisha said, “Please, let a double portion of your spirit be upon me.” **2 Kings 2:9**

When Elisha became sick with the illness of which he was to die, Joash the king of Israel came down to him and wept over him and said, “My father, my father, the chariots of Israel and its horsemen!” **2 Kings 13:14**

Elisha said to him, “Take a bow and arrows.” So he took a bow and arrows. Then he said to the king of Israel, “Put your hand on the bow.” And he put his hand on it, then Elisha laid his hands on the king's hands. **2 Kings 13:15**

## 3. Live a life that \_\_\_\_\_ your faith.

Blessed be the LORD my Rock, who trains my hands for war, and my fingers for battle. **Psalm 144:1**

The LORD's arrow of victory, even the arrow of victory over Aram; for you will defeat the Arameans at Aphek until you have destroyed them. **2 Kings 13:17**

So the man of God was angry with him and said, “You should have struck five or six times, then you would have struck Aram until you would have destroyed it. But now you shall strike Aram only three times.” **2 Kings 13:19**

## 4. Leave a \_\_\_\_\_ of faith.

Elisha died, and they buried him. Now the bands of the Moabites would invade the land in the spring of the year. As they were burying a man, behold, they saw a marauding band; and they cast the man into the grave of Elisha. And when the man touched the bones of Elisha he revived and stood up on his feet. **2 Kings 13:20-21**

**2 Kings 13:21**
