

Our Tentative Schedule – More Station Information

You will need a device that can stream YouTube. If you wish to have your children’s comments and ideas sent in via the chat feature in YouTube, you will need an account to log in (if you have Gmail or a Google account, you can use that.) An ideal set up is to have YouTube on a TV for viewing and use a phone, tablet or computer for the keyboard, if you want to use the chat. We would love to have you interact with us in the chat, but it is optional.

Sing-N-Play Express 9-9:30	This station is sometimes called “opening worship.” We sing, hear the day’s Bible Point, meet the Bible Buddy for each day, have a visit from a new friend, Cam Track, and are introduced to the new day. We are learning through music, movement, listening and seeing.

KidVid Cinema 9:30-10 approx	At KidVid Cinema, we see the Bible Point in action in the lives of real kids. We watch a video, discuss it, look at the daily Bible verse and get our Bible Buddies. We learn through talking, interpersonal interaction and listening and seeing.
<p><i>Preschoolers can “switch tracks” here. Age-appropriate Bible Adventures and the Craft & Play station will have pre-recorded videos for you to view with preschoolers. If you have a mixed group of preschoolers and elementary aged children, you have some choices. The preschoolers can continue with the older children, though they will not have the Imagination Station gizmos in their Travel Kit (some have parts that are choking hazards or are not developmentally appropriate).</i></p>	
Elementary-age Bible Adventures 10-10:30 approx.	The Bible account for each day comes to life here! True stories from the Bible help us understand the daily Bible point as we hear and re-enact and feel what happened in these accounts. Get ready to make a ship from pillows or cushions and a jail from kitchen chairs! We learn through doing, sensing, empathizing, feeling, seeing and listening.
Imagination Station – Elementary 10:30-11:00 approx	Only the elementary Travel Kits will have the science-y fun gizmos for Imagination Station. These gizmos remind us of our Bible Point through science such as hovering, “perpetual,” momentum, etc. The learning happens through doing, play, connections/symbols, and discussion.
Optional	We will be providing registrants with snack ideas that go with our theme or Bible Point and game ideas also (these are mostly outdoor type games).
